NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Chapter 11, 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia as amended that the Northumberland County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, November 8, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Northumberland County Courts Building at 39 Judicial Place in Heathsville, adjacent to the Sheriff's Office, to consider the following requests:

1. Request by Lori Crawley, owner, for a Conditional Use Permit to establish a two-family dwelling at 5243 Jesse Dupont Memorial Highway in Wicomico Church. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #42-(1)-162, Wicomico Magisterial District.
2. Request by Bradley L. And Elizabeth J. Worsham, owners, for a Special Exceptions Permit to construct a 22' x 38' x 20' open-sided boathouse alongside a proposed pier at 92 Tipers Circle in Great Wicomico Bluffs Subdivision. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #36B-(1)-32, Wicomico Magisterial District.
3. Request by Robert and Katie Berry, owners, for an Exception to the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Ordinance to reconstruct a portion of an existing dwelling that is within the seaward 50' of the Resource Protection Area buffer at 586 Fox Point Road. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #37-(1)-204A, Fairfield Magisterial District.
4. Request by Sharon and David Fine, owners, and Susan Elliott, applicant, for a Conditional Use Permit to operate a precious metals shop at 25 Sandy Street in Callao. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #8B-(1)-66B, Lottsburg Magisterial District.
5. Request by Pritchard & Fallin Properties, LLC, owner, and Terri and Larry Coleman, applicants, for a Special Exceptions Permit to operate public amusement (arcade) at 765 Northumberland Highway in Callao. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #8-(1)-114A, Lottsburg Magisterial District.
6. Request by Richard N. and Elizabeth K. Rounds, owners, for an Exception to the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Ordinance to rebuild a dwelling that would be partially within the seaward 50' of the Resource Protection Area buffer at 321 Fairway Drive in Indian Creek Estates Subdivision. The property is shown as Tax Map Parcel #53A-(2)-36, Wicomico Magisterial District.
