

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 28.2-1302 of the Code of Virginia, that the Northumberland County Wetlands Board, at a meeting in the Board of Supervisors Room of the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, Virginia, on **Tuesday, August 11, 2009, commencing at 7:30 P.M.**, will consider the following applications for wetland and/or coastal primary sand dune and beach permits:

- 1) Request by Fred A. Anderson (V.M.R.C. #09-0948) to install 90 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Kent Cove and 185 Kent Cove Road.
- 2) Request by Donald Arbuckle, et al (V.M.R.C. #09-0981) to install 172 linear feet of marsh toe stabilization along the shoreline of Bridge Creek and 765 Oyster Point Road.
- 3) Request by J. Carter and Carol Fox (V.M.R.C. #09-0936) to install 33 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of the Great Wicomico River and 2046 Whays Creek Road.
- 4) Request by Timothy and Bonnie Halstead (V.M.R.C. #09-0924) to construct 97 linear feet, including return wall, of timber bulkhead along the shoreline of Cod Creek and 147 Arthur Court, Sherwood Forest Subdivision.
- 5) Request by Ilva S. Madej (V.M.R.C. #09-0943) to install 465 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of the Great Wicomico River and 2415 Mila Road.
- 6) Request by Helen Snyder (V.M.R.C. #09-00949) to construct 59 linear feet of vinyl bulkhead 2' channelward of an existing bulkhead and 45 linear feet of bulkhead in same footprint as existing deteriorated bulkhead along the shoreline of Kingscote Creek and 477 Lake Francis Lane.

The applications requesting the proposed permits are on file in the Office of Building and Zoning at the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, VA, where all interested parties may view and inspect the projects.
