

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 28.2-1302 of the Code of Virginia, that the Northumberland County Wetlands Board, at a meeting in the Board of Supervisors Room of the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, Virginia, on **Tuesday, April 13, 2010, commencing at 7:30 P.M.**, will consider the following applications for wetland and/or coastal primary sand dune and beach permits:

- 1) Request by Ralph W. Findley (V.M.R.C. #10-0360) to install 250 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Cockrells Creek and 299 Buzzards Point Road.
- 2) Request by John and Carol Higbee (V.M.R.C. #10-0380) to install 200 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of the Little Wicomico River and 2634 Lighthouse View Drive
- 3) Request by Marshall L. and Anne M. Magee (V.M.R.C. #10-0369) to construct 189 linear feet of timber bulkhead, 95 feet of which will be 2' channelward of an existing failing bulkhead, along the shoreline of Bridge Creek and 939 Sunnybank Road.
- 4) Request by Thomas O. Marcey (V.M.R.C. #10-0314) to install 195 linear feet of marsh toe stabilization and install 550 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Cockrell Creek and Tax Map Parcel #38A-(1)-62D on Buzzards Point Road.
- 5) Request by William and Connie Moslow (V.M.R.C. #10-0417) to install a 60 linear foot riprap sill with 180 cu. yds. of high quality sand nourishment and wetland vegetation plantings along the shoreline of Indian Creek and 474 Sandy Run Trail.
- 6) Request by Robert and Dana Nicholas (V.M.R.C. #10-0303) to install 311 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Wilkins Creek and Tax Map Parcel #2-(1)-76J on Long Point Road.
- 7) Request by John Warren, et al (V.M.R.C. #10-0436) to construct 720 linear feet of bulkhead and construct 11 groins along and from the shoreline of the Coan River and Tax Map Parcel #11-(1)-1A on Walnut Point Road.
- 8) Request by Bernard F. Whittkamp, Jr. (V.M.R.C. #10-0234) to construct 297 linear feet of vinyl bulkhead with riprap armor stone scour protection and to remove five (5) deteriorated timber groins and construct five (5) replacement, low-profile timber groins that vary from 44' to 48' from MHW, along the shoreline of the Potomac River and 845 Virmar Beach Road.
