

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 28.2-1302 of the Code of Virginia, that the Northumberland County Wetlands Board, at a meeting in the Board of Supervisors Room of the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, Virginia, on **Tuesday, November 13, 2012, commencing at 7:00 P.M.**, will consider the following applications for wetland and/or coastal primary sand dune and beach permits:

- 1) Request by Ralph E. Dove (V.M.R.C. #12-1584) to remove an existing deteriorated timber bulkhead and construct 153 linear feet of timber bulkhead along the shoreline of Little Taskmakers Creek and 38 Gladys Lane.
- 2) Request by Samantha Futrell.(V.M.R.C. #12-1581) to construct a low-profile groin 48 feet in length and extend an existing groin 18 feet landward from the shoreline of Hull Creek and 1194 Candy Point Road.
- 3) Request by Thomas H. Payne (V.M.R.C. #12-1593) to install 55 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Presley Creek and 182 Colorado Drive.
- 4) Request by Stephen M. and Jamie M. Tucker (V.M.R.C. #12-1585) to install 30 linear feet of riprap sill with 7 cubic yards of beach nourishment and plant nourishment area with wetlands vegetation along the shoreline of The Great Wicomico River and 158 Great View Drive.
- 5) Request by Warren C. Zuger (V.M.R.C. #12-1551) to install 220 linear feet of riprap revetment channelward of an existing deteriorated timber bulkhead along the shoreline of the Yeocomico River and 3038 Mundy Point Road.

The applications requesting the proposed permits are on file in the Office of Building and Zoning at the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, VA, where all interested parties may view and inspect the projects.
