

JUNE 13 AND OCTOBER 17

Lancaster/Northumberland Residential Hazardous Waste Collections

Lancaster and Northumberland County residents can mark their calendars for two scheduled county-sponsored Hazardous Waste Collections in 2009: Saturdays, June 13 and October 17. Residents are encouraged to set aside and bring household hazardous waste products for safe disposal at these Collections. Through these spring and fall two-county collections, residents can, with small effort and *little or no cost*, have a positive impact on the health of our fragile coastal environment.

Drop-offs should be made to specified sites in the counties, with Lancaster County drop-offs received in the morning, and Northumberland, in the afternoon.

Lancaster County drop-offs will be accepted from 7:30 – 11:00 AM at the Kilmarnock Refuse Center, 320 White Pine Drive, (off Rte. 200 across from Hills Quarters). The first 50 pounds of waste are accepted FREE of charge for *each resident*; overages will be assessed at \$1.03/lb.

Northumberland County drop-offs will be accepted from 1:00 – 4:30 PM at the Horsehead Refuse Center, 1175 Northumberland Highway (Rte. 360). Here, the first 30 pounds are FREE, then \$1.03/pound.

Please DO BRING: Spent fluorescent bulbs (including Compact Fluorescents), Unwanted Pesticides, Antifreeze, NiCad and Rechargeable Batteries, Cleaners, Paint, Old/Contaminated Fuels, Household Chemicals, etc.

DON'T BRING: Tires, Car Batteries, Radioactives, Medical Waste, Ammo/Related Explosives

Staff of Lancaster/Northumberland Virginia Cooperative Extension and Northern Neck Soil & Water Conservation District will assist the two counties in the collection.
