Magazines and Catalogs

Office Stationery and Mail

Telephone Books

No heavily waxed containers, waxed paper or cellophane.

Cardboard

All Cardboard - includes corrugated and cereal & frozen food boxes

Collapse boxes to allow for more room in the bin.



Plastics

#1, #2 and #3 Plastic containers and bags *only*. Insert these plastics in the same bin.

Plastics numbers are found on the bottom of the container (within triangle of arrows).

Remove all caps and rings on bottlenecks.

Metal

All Metal Cans including lids

Clean Aluminum Foil

All other items made of metal can be placed in a separate, open-ended container.

Oil



Glass

Bottles and Jars of any color

Remove all rings, caps and lids.

Batteries

Car, Appliance, Flashlight and Communication Device batteries

Rechargeable batteries

Give batteries to the Waste Management attendee.

Labels do not need to be removed from containers.

Do not tie any materials with string or place in plastic bags.

Deposit as individual items.
