
NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, VIRGINIA

Take U.S. 301 South. Cross the bridge over the Potomac River. Left on VA Hwy 3 (Kings Hwy) and proceed through Montross, VA. Left on VA Hwy 202 (Cople Hwy) and proceed to Callao.

From Norfolk, VA.
From I-64 take US-17 North. At Gloucester, right on VA Hwy 3 (John Clayton Memorial Hwy) and proceed to Kilmarnock. At city center, right on VA Hwy 200 (East Church Street) to Wicomico Church. Approximately 85 miles.
