The Northumberland County Electoral Board (the "Board") convened at 12:11 p.m. to commence the canvass of returns for the November 4, 2025 general election, pursuant to Title 24.2 of the Code of Virginia and guidelines issued by the Virginia Department of Elections.

The Secretary called the canvass to order, subject to recess and reconvening as required. The Board reviewed statutory and regulatory procedures governing the canvass, including timing restrictions on the processing of certain ballot categories.

The Board adopted the following verification protocol for all precincts:

- Comparison of the Election Day call-in report, Ballot Record Report (BRR),
  Statement of Results (SOR), and scanner tapes;
- Confirmation of election officer oaths and ballot receipts;
- Review of write-in ballots for acceptability; and Mig 00th is beareout assumed and
- Verification of early voting totals.
