

**NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY WETLANDS BOARD
DECEMBER 12, 2023
MINUTES**

At the regular monthly meeting of the Northumberland County Wetlands Board held on December 12, 2023 in the Sheriff's Office in Heathsville, Virginia at 7:00 PM:

Harry Towne, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

On a motion by George Rew, seconded by Albert Fisher, the minutes of the November 14, 2023 meeting were unanimously approved.

Application No. 23-2521

Frank B. Blanton – to install 35 linear feet of armor stone revetment landward of an existing damaged bulkhead along the shoreline of Judith Sound and 299 Judith Sound Road.

Roger McKinley, agent for the owner, was present and described the project. He then requested a three-year permit.

After review of the project, George Rew made a motion to approve the application for three years. Albert Fisher seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved.

Application No. 23-2490

Carol A. Terenzi – to install 100 linear feet of riprap sill and install 115 linear feet of riprap revetment along the shoreline of Owens Pond and 755 Twin Harbor Road.

Joseph Scott, agent for the owner, described the project and requested a three-year permit.

Albert Fisher noted that the project looked to be an appropriate plan for the site.

No concerns were noted.

There being no objections, Albert Fisher made a motion to approve the application as submitted for three years. Lewis Howard seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved.

Other Business

Philip Marston informed the Board that Lisa Biever has requested that the application for Northern Neck Land Conservancy (VMRC #23-2312) be tabled until the January meeting.

After consideration, George Rew made a motion to table the request until the January 9, 2024 meeting. Albert Fisher seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved.

There being no further business to come before the Board, on a motion by Lewis Howard seconded by Lewis Howard, the Board unanimously voted to adjourn.
